# Tips to Help Find a Local Therapist or Counselor

## **Therapist Directories:**

Search online provider directories for local providers. These databases are often easy to navigate and you can search by insurance type to quickly see who is accepting new patients.

## **Health Insurance:**

Call your insurance provider or visit their website for a list of mental health providers who accept your insurance. Your employee benefit plan (EAP) may also have a list of local providers. Check your coverage carefully by asking the following questions:

- Does my health insurance plan include mental health benefits?
- What is my deductible and has it been met yet?
- How many sessions per year does my health insurance cover?
- Do I need prior authorization from my primary care provider to have these services covered?

## **Virtual Care:**

Virtual care is another option if you would like to quickly establish care. Many Montana-based mental health clinicians will provide virtual or in-person therapy. A variety of organizations offer virtual therapy, including:

## **Be Persistent:**

Keep in mind that it can take multiple attempts to find a provider. Many people find they need to contact 5 to 10 mental health providers to find someone accepting new patients. It is OK to request to be put on a waitlist or to ask for a consultation with a provider to help determine if they're the right provider for you.
